The Neonatal units within the East Midlands Neonatal Operational Delivery Network (EMNODN) are now able to offer the use of FaceTime, which enables mothers whose babies are transferred to another Network hospital shortly after delivery to:

- See their baby
- Meet the staff providing their baby's care
- Discuss their baby's care needs

A member of staff will be present with both mother and baby for the duration of all FaceTime communications.

You may be required to sign a consent form prior to any FaceTime communications.

There may be occasions when we are not able to achieve a connection. If this occurs it may be possible for parents/relatives to use their personal devices to access this service.
