Course includes:

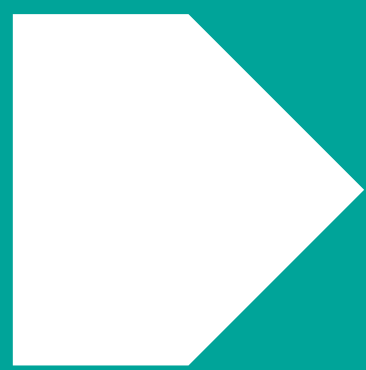
- 11 x virtual study days

All applications must:

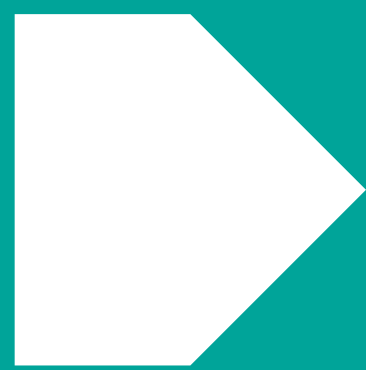
- Have line manager agreement

- Be willing to contribute to feedback



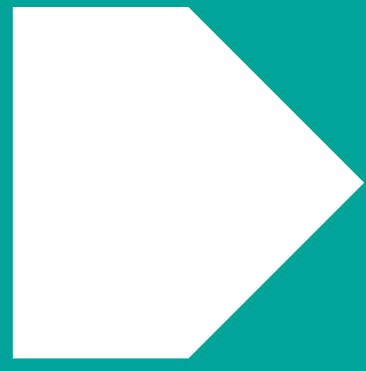
